Navigation Warning - Desalination Project

Mariners are advised that as part of the construction of Sydney's Desalination Plant at Kurnell, offshore construction works commenced on 1 October 2007 with an anticipated completion date of 28 February 2010.

THE OPERATION

Blue Water Joint Venture is installing offshore intake and outlet risers. The construction works comprise the installation of rock anchors and anchor buoys, the establishment of self elevating drilling and service platforms, the drilling of the riser excavation and the use of service craft such as barges and divers. The construction work will be located approximately 0.5 km offshore between Cape Solander and Cape Bailey.

Construction work may be carried out 24 hours per day 7 days per week.

The service craft will display the appropriate day shapes and lights at night.

Vessels are advised to keep well clear of the service craft and equipment. Persons operating vessels in the vicinity are reminded of their obligation to maintain their speed at no more than 4 knots within 100 metres of floating plant or work in progress with vessel wash to be kept to a minimum and to keep a good lookout at all time for any divers above and below the surface.
